Lou and her thoroughbreds compete throughout the levels both at regional and National level. Lou, herself, has won regional and National Dressage titles both on her ex-racehorses and her warmbloods as well.

Lou retrains for various Owners, her most noted being HM The Queen, who currently has three horses based with Thoroughbred Dressage; Quadrille, Princes Trust and Forthbridge. Quadrille is currently the highest competing ex racehorse in the UK, with the hopes of competing at the highest level, Grand Prix, on the very near future. In 2019, Quadrille was awarded the most prestigious award being the RoR Horse of the Year title for 2019.

Alongside competing, Lou helps others on their retraining journey and helps ex-racehorses find their new homes post racing. Thoroughbred Dressage has rehomed ex-racehorses across the UK and across the world. Through teaching clinics held across the UK (through the RoR and other clients) and her training programmes that are based on her website, Lou wants to help as many horse and rider combinations as possible to be able to create a happy partnership and give the ex-racehorses their best life possible in their second career post racing.
